## Bats in Ufton

Jo Harper, a Bat Ecologist, and a member of Warwickshire Bat Group gave a fabulous talk on Bats on 9<sup>th</sup> May 2024. As a result, two "bat" monitors have been placed in gardens in the village. The monitors record the bats' echo frequency, and this tells the ecologists what type of bats are around. We are looking forward to the results.
